

Independent Auditor's Limited Review Report on the Unaudited Standalone Financial Results of the Company for the quarter and nine months ended on 31st December, 2021.

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results of SUPREMEX SHINE STEELS LIMITED (the "Company"), for the quarter ended December 31, 2021 and year to date from April 01, 2021 to December 31, 2021 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations") read with SEBI Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016 and as amended by SEBI Circular No. CIR/CFD/CMD1/44/2019 dated March 29, 2019.



- 4 The Company has considered the possible effects that may result from COVID-19 on its business, performance & in the preparation of these financial results. The Company believes that the pandemic is unlikely to impact the recoverability of the carrying value of its assets as at 31st December, 2021. Looking at the present situation of pandemic, the extent to which the same will impact Company's future financial results is currently uncertain and will depend on further developments. The Company has taken and shall continue to take various precautionary measures to secure the health and safety of its employees and their families from COVID-19.
- 5 The entire operation of the Company relate to only one segment viz. Business in Trading in Steels and Acting. Hence, Ind AS - 108 is not applicable.
